Performances: Friday, July 29, 6:10 & 8:10 PM

Auditions:

- Campers desiring a solo must participate in an audition held **Monday, July 11** (6:30-8:30 PM) *OR* **Tuesday, July 12** (4:00-6:00 PM) at Hope Christian Fellowship, 4173 Bludau Drive in Vint Hill, Warrenton, VA. Participants who are unable to attend an audition may submit a video audition that includes at least one song from Willy Wonka (can be performed a cappella); contact us for more information.
- It is not necessary to be at both audition nights. Only one audition will be allowed for each camper.
- Auditioning campers should come prepared to sing a song from the show, according to the part desired. Audition resources are posted at **www.hopepcf.net**

Camp Requirements:

- All campers are expected to become familiar with the music *before* camp week. Leads should memorize dialogue prior to camp. CDs and scripts will be provided.
- All campers must attend *all* hours and days of camp, final dress rehearsal, and performances. There will be no excused absences.
- Campers should bring a lunch and adequate drinks each day.
- Campers are expected to arrive on time and be picked up promptly.
- Rehearsal CDs & scripts must be returned at the end of camp for copyright purposes.

Parent Volunteer Opportunities:

- Secure sponsors to underwrite production costs and donations for fund-raising concessions (proceeds support CareNet Pregnancy Resource Centers).
- Sell concessions, hand out programs, sew costumes, build sets, etc. "All hands on deck!"
- Organize cast party following the performance.
- Provide snacks for rehearsal days.
- Video record and copy the performance for distribution to the campers at a minimal fee.
